LSA's Defended Eviction Project: Preventing homelessness aims to help those facing the loss of their home. It endeavours to provide tenants, home owners and members of their family with advice and representation. It also deals with homelessness law.

Tenants: Helpdesk at Glasgow Sheriff Court

- Every Tuesday immediately before the eviction court sits, from 9.30am and 1.30pm (please arrive early)
- Situated near actual courtroom
- Available to all tenants involved in cases at Glasgow Sheriff Court
- Provides initial advice and, where appropriate, representation
- Staffed by experienced lawyers and other LSA staff
- Free to the service user

Drop-in surgeries at Fleming House

- Every Monday before the eviction court sits from 11.00am – 12.30pm (defended eviction only)
- Every Wednesday from 11.00am – 12.30pm and 2.00 – 4.00pm, **any topic**

Homeowners

- Mortgage borrowers' rights when facing eviction
- Rights of those facing eviction through debt or bankruptcy
- Initial advice free to the service user
- Drop-in surgeries every Wednesday from 11.00am – 12.30pm and 2.00 – 4.00pm
