Support and advice for children and young people

If you are in Scotland as a refugee, asylum seeker or migrant, you have certain rights under the law. These rights vary depending on your age; whether you are here on your own or with your family; and whether you arrived in Scotland with the permission of the authorities or not.

We can also help if you are a student from abroad or a visitor for any other reason. This includes temporary or long term employment or self employment.

The LSA Young Persons' Project can help:

- Whether you are with your family or separated from them
- Whether you know you have permission to stay in the UK or not

This might include helping you with your rights to:

- Asylum and immigration
- Support, such as somewhere safe to stay and living costs
- Education
- Protection from abuse
- Social work and the children's hearing system
- Homelessness and housing
- Right to work, and rights in work
