Legal advice and representation includes:

- Free advice and assistance to homeless applicants including reviews/appeals
- Defending eviction actions, including representation at Greenock Sheriff Court
- Advice on rent arrears and housing benefit issues
- Advice on mortgage arrears
- Help for homeowners facing repossession including advice and court representation
- Housing disrepair and landlord/tenant matters.
- Analysis of other legal problems
